## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

**2000-1030. *Ohio Hosp. Assn. v. Armstrong World Industries, Inc.***

Cuyahoga App. No. 76067. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County. On April 13, 2001, this court stayed further proceedings in this case and ordered appellee to file a notice with this court upon the termination of the automatic stay under the Bankruptcy Code.

It is ordered by the Court, sua sponte, that appellee W.R. Grace & Son & Co.-Conn. file a notice advising this court of the status of the bankruptcy case within 15 days of the date of this entry.

### **2007-1579. Cuyahoga Cty. Bar Assn. v. Church.**

It is ordered by this court, sua sponte, that Joseph J. Church, Attorney Registration No. 0006961, last known business address in Solon, Ohio, is found in contempt for failure to comply with this court's order of January 17, 2008, to wit: failure to file an affidavit of compliance on or before February 19, 2008.

### **2008-0390. Toledo Bar Assn. v. Weisberg.**

This cause is pending before the court upon the filing of a report by the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline on December 17, 2008. Upon consideration thereof,

It is ordered by the court, sua sponte, that proceedings in this case are stayed until respondent has served his entire sentence in United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio, No. 3:05cr763-01, *United States of America v. Weisberg*, including the three-year period of supervised release and until further order of this court. Upon completion of the sentence, respondent shall file proof of such with this court.

It is further ordered that respondent will remain under suspension in 2007-0309, *In re Weisberg*.

### **2008-0772. Cuyahoga Cty. Bar Assn. v. Freedman.**
